

INFORMATION GENERAL AVIATION

Operational Hours

- 06:30-20:00 LT
- Landings of commercial flights only are possible until 23:00 LT.

Operational Requirements

- Slots: Required on day 6+7 during winter season and on 02+09 JAN only
- PPR: not needed
- Parking restrictions: during winter season maximum parking 60 minutes from Thursday evening until Sunday evening (please check latest NOTAM)

External services providers

- Fuel: Jet A-1 and Avgas available via Air BP. Payment only with BP card, fuel release or cash – no credit card!
- Catering: available via Cloud Number 9. Please order all items (also ice, coffee, hot water) via Cloud N. 9.
- Cleaning: available via Star Clean

Security and Safety

- Screening: all crew, passengers and luggage will be screened
- High visibility closing is mandatory on the apron

Customs and border control

- Border control: available during operating hours (only needed for non-Schengen flights)
- Customs: if you need customs, please inform us in advance and we will coordinate with them
- Permission: For permission to fly from/to Austria, please refer to Austrian CAA (Austro Control, see link below). We do not arrange this kind of permission.

- Submission of passenger data: all commercial airlines shall be obliged to provide passenger data concerning non-Schengen flights to Austria before the flight starts. These data shall be forwarded to the following address:

- de-icing/anti-icing: available (type 1 and 2)

Additional information

- APU running time maximum 30 minutes after landing and 30 minutes before departure
- Apron access for cars: not possible, except for ambulance flights
- Marshaller will be provided
